

Safety Data Sheet - Technical Bulletin

This document is to provide clarification regarding the need of Safety Data Sheets for the products that Gordon Brush[®] manufactures.

In accordance to the Hazard Communication Standard of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration, SDS's are required for all hazardous chemicals: however, the Standard specifically exempts all "Articles" from this requirement [29 CRF 1910.1200(b)(6)(v)].

"Articles" by definition of the Standard, "means a manufactured item other than a fluid or particle: (i) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture; (ii) has end use functions dependent in whole or in part upon its shape and design during end use; and (iii) which under normal conditions of use does not release more than very small quantities, e.g., minute or trace amounts of a hazardous chemical (as determined under paragraph (d) of this section), and does not pose a physical hazard or health risk to employees."

Gordon Brush[®] declares to the best of our knowledge that our product lines are "Articles" according to the above definition and are therefore exempt from MSDS requirements.
